We do not consider that the Local Planning Authority have complied with their duty to co-operate and follow due procedural requirements in identifying the housing need for the Local Plan area and, in particular, they have not correctly identified the number of houses for a 5 year supply during the plan period.

We consider that greater provision needs to be made for housing in the Local Plan area and, in particular, we consider that the development of land to the south-east of Blandford St. Mary could easily and simply be expanded to make a greater provision to the requirement for housing in the locality by expanding the area to the trackway known as Wards Drove which would enhance the cycle route link back up to Blandford by ensuring a more cohesive route back towards Blandford and would also ensure a more cohesive strategy to the identification of a safeguarded route for the Spetisbury and Charlton Marshall By-Pass as part of the development scheme because all key landowners would be involved in the safeguarding procedures. Therefore the expansion of the site to incorporate the land lying immediately south to the already identified area, but north of Wards Drove, is a key change necessary for this plan.
