There has been significant consultations and I have attended all public ones. At times those people like myself with properties in Gillingham but not living nearby were given very short time scales to attend meetings.

The significant bias of building to the south of Gillingham has been obvious and I question whether all other options were fully investigated. Looking at a plan of Gillingham the northern tranch would be a more encompassing development than the south.

In the light of the current climate changes, I am hugely concerned that the building to the south is predominantly on flood plain areas. Lodden has a local nick name ...' sodden Lodden...' and this indicates the level of flooding that does regularly occur. I am worried that this issue has not been taken seriously enough.

If we respond to counter any element of the current plan the response has been one single line in amongst the consultation documentation. At no point has the response been tackled other than in a dismissive way. I am aware that a plan such as this takes a vast amount of time, manpower and resourcing and I feel we are too far down the line now for any significant changes to be made.

Queries related to bottlenecks and fluidity of traffic flow still pose concerns for me.
