Most of which is on a hill, there is a stream which runs through the ~~opening~~ ^{entrance} or where the opening would be, it's about 2 metres wide.

② and about 20 metres long, but no doubt a bridge could over come that, like Brooklands, but if the field were to be flooded, the whole of Milborne would be under water. The 4 houses opposite Hopfield, next to Stileham bank, and plans for 2 more houses ~~to be~~ adjacent to Springfields opposite coles

have (all DTU 052) all flood plains. Also Goulds Farm

and Tilly Whim - The Causeway - all flood plains ^{but are successfully built} on. There are a good number

of entrances up Milton Road, so one more should not cause any problems.

As I said please view, before you condemn it, we think it would be ideal.
