Issue 11 Development Management Policies

At paragraph 10.18, the AONB welcomes the addition but notes that the reference to AONBs and their settings has been added to the bullet point relating to local landscapes. AONBs are, of course, national designations. The addition, 'such as the AONBs and their settings', should be moved to the first bullet point so that it then reads 'relevant national landscape designations, such as the AONBs and their settings'.

The precise change and/or wording being sought:

10.18 Every renewable and low carbon energy development proposal that has the potential to have adverse visual and landscape impacts should be supported by an assessment of the potential impacts, which should also set out any proposed mitigation measures. This site-based assessment should have regard to all relevant landscape and visual factors including:

- *relevant national landscape designations, **such as the AONBs and their settings**'.*
