



The footbridge between the Red Lion and Waitrose is the main pedestrian access point from the High Street to the south of the Stour. The open area of ground in the background is the Red Lion redevelopment area.

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Figure 18 shows the managed area on the banks of the River Stour. The vegetation has been cut back and a hard surface area created to give easy access to the watercourse. The area is well used, as it is one of few points in the vicinity where access to the river is possible.

Figure 19 shows the confluence of Shreen Water and the Stour, to the south of the Town Bridge. The wooded nature of this stretch of Shreen Water is highlighted, with thick vegetation along the banks. In the foreground the lower level river vegetation is visible.
