

## Contaminated land – public register

Purbeck District Council maintains a register of land declared as contaminated under the meaning of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 Part 2A (The definition of contaminated land is given below but does not include land that has been remediated through the planning and development control process).

The register is intended to act as a full and permanent record of all the regulatory action taken by the enforcing authority in relation to the remediation of contaminated land. The register will be updated with information as it becomes available.

### Contaminated land is defined as:

- any land which appears to the local authority in whose land it is situated to be in such a condition, by reason of substances in, on or under the land, that significant harm is being caused or there is a significant possibility of such harm being caused; or that pollution of controlled waters is being, or is likely to be, caused.
