THE COURT ORDERED THAT

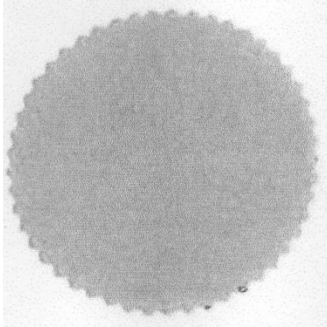
- 1) The appeal be dismissed
